<b>NKX v Barts Health NHS Trust</b> [2020] EWHC 828 (QB)	<b>Midwifery and Obstetrics.</b> Failure to warn / consent regarding alternate means of fetal monitoring. Secondary allegations about negligent management.	<b>C.</b> Failure to warn and negligent management.
<b>Pepper v Royal Free London NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2020] EWHC 310 (QB)	<b>Pancreatic surgery.</b> Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>D.</b> No negligence and informed consent obtained.
<b>Mordel v Royal Berkshire NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2019] EWHC 2591 (QB)	<b>Midwifery.</b> Down's screening. Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>C.</b> Negligence and failure to obtain informed consent.
<b>Mills v Oxford University Hospitals NHS Trust</b> [2019] EWHC 936 (QB)	<b>Neurosurgery.</b> Brain surgery. Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>C.</b> No negligence, but failure to obtain informed consent. Causation established.
<b>Ollosson v Lee</b> [2019] EWHC 784 (QB)	<b>Urology.</b> Vasectomy. Consent only.	<b>D.</b> Adequately informed as to risk of procedure.
<b>Keh v Homerton University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2019] EWHC 548 (QB)	<b>Obstetrics.</b> Sepsis following C-section. Consent and secondary allegations of negligent post-operative care.	<b>D.</b> Informed consent and no negligence in post-operative care.

<b>Kennedy v Frankel</b> [2019] EWHC 106 (QB)	<b>Neurology.</b> Suspected Parkinson's disease. Failure to provide advice about risk and alert to side effects.	<b>C.</b> No informed consent, but not causative. Collateral negligence over advice regarding side effects. Causation established.
<b>Duce v Worcestershire Acute Hospitals NHS Trust</b> [2018] EWCA Civ 1307	<b>Gynaecology.</b> CPSP following hysterectomy. Consent only.	<b>D.</b> Informed consent. Bolam relevant to question of whether gynaecologists were or should have been aware of relevant risks.
<b>Hassell v Hillingdon Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2018] EWHC 164 (QB)	<b>Spinal Orthopaedic.</b> Elective spinal surgery. Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>C.</b> No negligence, but failure to obtain informed consent. Causation established.
<b>Gallardo v Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust</b> [2017] EWHC 3147 (QB)	<b>General Surgery.</b> Abdominal tumour surgery. Duty to inform the patient of its outcome, the prognosis, and of any requirement for follow-up and further treatment or monitoring	<b>C.</b> Negligent advice. C argued, following Montgomery, that Bolam test did not apply to post-operative advice or information. Not clear whether Judge relied on this.
<b>Diamond v Royal Devon &amp; Exeter NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2017] EWHC 1495 (QB) (unsuccessful appeal: [2019] EWCA Civ 585)	<b>Spinal Orthopaedic and General Surgery.</b> Spinal and Abdominal surgery. Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>C, in part.</b> Negligence in surgery. No informed consent, but not causative.
<b>Thefaut v Johnston</b> [2017] EWHC 497 (QB)	<b>Neurosurgery.</b> Elective spinal surgery. Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>C.</b> No negligence, but failure to obtain informed consent. Causation established.
<b>Webster (A Child) v Burton Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2017] EWCA Civ 62	<b>Midwifery and Obstetrics.</b> Negligence fetal monitoring. Issues as to timing and advice as to induction.	<b>C.</b> Trial had taken place prior to Montgomery, but outcome reversed applying SC judgment.
<b>Holdsworth v Luton And Dunstable University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2016] EWHC 3347 (QB)	<b>Orthopaedics.</b> Knee replacement surgery. Negligence and consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>D.</b> No negligence and informed consent obtained.
<b>Crossman v St George's Healthcare NHS Trust</b> [2016] EWHC 2878 (QB)	<b>Neurosurgery.</b> Elective spinal surgery. Consent allegations, Montgomery informing latter.	<b>C.</b> Failure to obtain informed consent. Causation established.
<b>MC v Birmingham Women's NHS Foundation Trust</b> [2016] EWHC 1334 (QB)	<b>Midwifery and Obstetrics.</b> Birth injury. Issues as to timing and advice as to induction.	<b>D.</b> No negligence and informed consent obtained.
